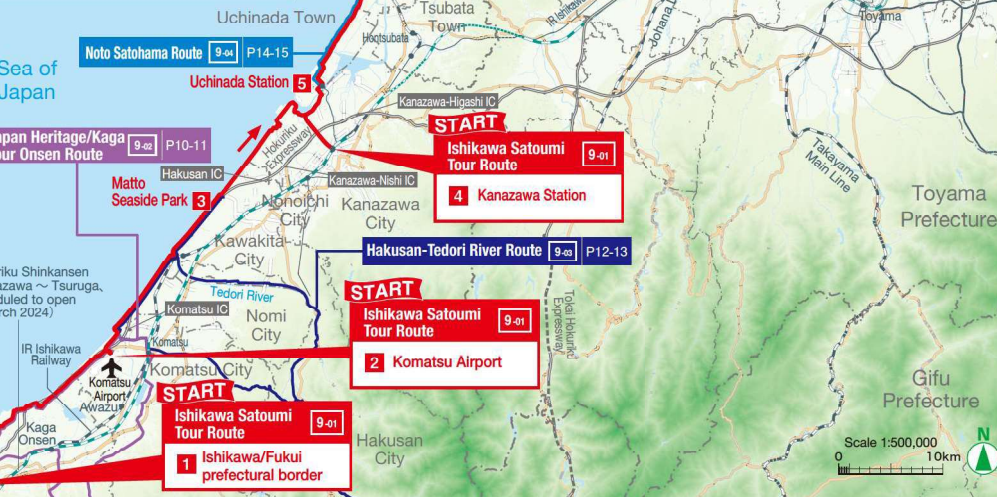
8 Ganmon sea cave 9 Yoshitsune no Funakakushi

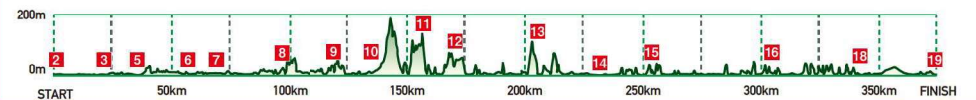


Ishikawa Satoumi Tour Route

A long route making use of the entire Ishikawa Satoumi shoreline. Immerse yourself in the calm clear waters of Uchiura, with its stretching sandy beaches, the setting of rugged rock formations shaped by wild waves, and the traditional scenery of Japanese farming and fishing villages.

Land route starts here

Typical Noto Kongo landscape

7 Chirihama Nagisa Driveway
[9-04] Noto Satoyama Route
The only place in Japan where you can enjoy a long ride right on the sandy beach.

6 Takamatsu Roadside Station (Satoumi-kan)
[9-04] Noto Satoyama Route
Service area easy to drop in from the cycling path

9 Yoshitsune no Funakakushi
The cliff-lined inlet where Yoshitsune and his crew members were said to have hid his boat while escaping.

10 Sojiji Soin Temple
Developed as the central temple of Soto Zen. Sojiji Street spreads out in front of the gate

16 Anamizu Roadside Station

A café for cyclists is on the opposite side

Rock formation, also known as Gunkan (Battleship) Island
